A statewide requirement to wear a face covering that has been in place since July could end “pretty soon,” according to Governor Greg Abbott.

Abbott said during televised remarks in Corpus Christi on Thursday, “We’re working right now on evaluating when we’re going to be able to remove all statewide orders, and we will be making announcements about that pretty soon.” The mask requirement is part of an executive order issued under the Texas Disaster Act. Compliance has varied throughout Texas. If the order is ended, bigbox retailers like Walmart and Target might continue to require masking in accordance with policies set by their national headquarters. Some local governments might also continue to require masking, depending on whether the governor allows that. As the state emerges from the pandemic, a patchwork of different standards and rules are likely to emerge, with some private businesses taking a strict approach while others abandon the pandemic-era protocols altogether.
